Published Guides

Chamber Music Repertoire for Amateur Players by Harold Haynes \$20-24

Works are standard repertoire. Difficulty is rated 1-20. Not every part for every piece is rated. First violin, cello, and piano are always rated. Challenging pieces but ratings identify easier movements. Very useful for students breaking into standard repertoire.

We Are the Music Makers – A Graded Guide to Chamber Music \$17-22

Volume I String Quartets

Volume II String Trios

Volume III Clarinet, String, and Piano Chamber Music

Difficulty is rated 1-6. Each instrument is rated for every movement. Pieces are cataloged both by composer and by level. All are standard repertoire. This series includes some repertoire that is easier than that in Haynes' guide. All pieces in Volume III include clarinet.

The Piano in Chamber Ensemble by Maurice Hinson \$46

The most extensive guide to piano chamber music. It only has three levels: intermediate (above average high school students) to difficult (advanced performers). Very few "intermediate" pieces are included. Brief descriptions are given for many pieces.

IMSLP

imslp.org

IMSLP is a source of public domain music. The menu at the top allows you to browse by ensemble size and instrumentation. When looking at a piece, the [View] option allows you to see the music without downloading it.

Arne Dich

Arne Dich has arranged pieces for two to five part ensembles and offers the scores for free on his website. He supplies transpositions and alternate clefs for the parts making it possible to use a wide variety of instruments.
